Blade Sharpening Guide

To maintain the performance of the BlackEdge blade, be sure to follow the recommended steps for sharpening.



1

Before any sharpening, and especially the first time, it is essential to methodically move the BlackEdge blade across the cross grind wheel to remove the extra carbon located under the blade only.

At the end of this essential operation, the stainless steel will be visible only in this location. The carbon coating located on the edge of the blade will remain intact.

Select the player's desired cut. All types of profiles work. Carefully carry out the sharpening, being sure not to damage the edge.

To prevent damage to the carbon coating on the edge of the blade, use a soft cloth to remove the debris at the end of the sharpening. Inspect your work and correct it if necessary.



At the end of the sharpening, it is not recommended to repetitively use a sharpening stone, as this could damage the edge of the BlackEdge blade.



Between events on the ice, avoid excessive use of a sharpening tool, as this could damage the edge of the blade.
